Our 'Fight For America' Plan Includes 3 Projects

- Eliminate Election Fraud
- Reject Socialism
- Form a statewide organization



We will outline our basic plans for each of these projects now, but know that we will only launch those projects for which we get a sufficient number of Project Leaders and Team Members, when we call for volunteers.



Also, the plans that we will discuss tonight are big, and clearly, the Lehigh Valley Tea Party is not large enough to solve problems on a national level. However, we can still have major impact if we solve them locally, and serve as a model for other organizations across the nation.



Project #1

Eliminate Election Fraud



Eliminate Election Fraud

- The mission of this project must be to <u>prosecute</u> those directly responsible for fraud and unlawful election interference.
- While we must look at the various 'cheat' methods used, and while we must find ways to disable those methods, it is equally important to identify the people behind the methods (funding sources, coders, organizers, etc.) and prosecute them as well.
- Along with prosecutions, this project's highest priority would be federally mandated Voter ID. (Can't be left up to states because it would simply never happen in blue states.)

Eliminate Election Fraud – Cont'd

- Must find ways to ensure voting system computer security, or return to paper ballots and hand counting
- Voter registration rolls must be audited and clean-up procedures must be streamlined. (In PA it takes 8 years to remove a person who does not vote.)
- Must eliminate mail-in voting. Secure absentee voting with valid reason, witness signature & validated voter signature would be the only acceptable form of mail-in voting.



Eliminate Election Fraud – Cont'd

- Eliminate "curing" of ballots that contain errors, or omissions.
- Governors and other state officials who order changes to voting procedures must be prosecuted under federal law, as such changes are authorized by state legislatures only.
- Election observers must be allowed to monitor the ballotcounting processes without restriction, or obstruction.
- Social media companies must be prohibited from censoring news based on organizational bias. (*Repeal section 230*).

The above points are the basics and not meant to be all-inclusive of this plan.

As you can imagine, this project is incredibly complex. In order to succeed, it requires a team of people who are <u>dedicated</u> to solving the Election Fraud problem.

Project #2 Reject Socialism



Reject Socialism

- The primary mission of this project is to push back against the Left's march to socialism, and to take back lost ground.
- Find ways to successfully fight socialist indoctrination of our children in K-12 and higher education.
- Oppose acts of 'social justice' and promote 'merit justice'.
- Aggressively push back against "politically correct" language, and the Left's demand to eliminate gender references.



The 4 Components of our "Reject Socialism" Project

- <u>Educational</u>: aims to teach everywhere possible that socialism always means tyranny
- <u>Legislative</u>: work for laws that free us from tyranny (e.g., reduce Governor's state of emergency powers)
- <u>Political</u>: get Constitutionalists elected to local office, especially key power seats
- <u>Legal:</u> file civil and/or criminal complaints against those who abuse power

This project is extremely broad-scoped. In order to succeed, it requires multiple teams of people who are <u>dedicated</u> to education, legislation, politics and legal action.

Statewide Organization



Statewide Organization – Why Do We Need One?

- Currently, there is no unified conservative voice in PA.
- As large as the Lehigh Valley Tea Party is, we technically cover just 2 of PA's 67 counties and therefore, have little power beyond the valley.
- The majority of PA's republican state lawmakers vote as Leadership tells them, rather than their constituents.
- So, we need to pressure GOP leadership. These are the people calling the shots. Right now, they are influenced mainly by unions and lobbyists.

Statewide Organization – How might one work?

- We would potentially partner with 2 or 3 other groups in the area. (We won't name them just yet, as we don't want to create unfair pressure.)
- Founding groups would likely offer our members a first year membership in the new state group, at no charge.
- Additionally, we have over 17,500 people from across the state who signed our "Impeach Wolf" petition. We would give each, a one year membership. So, we'd likely start out with about 20,000 members and build from there.

Statewide Organization

- We would talk with former leaders of the many, now inactive, conservative 9/12 and Patriot groups across the state & ask them to invite their former members to join.
- We would invite other pro-Trump groups like Women for Trump, Bikers for Trump, Latino's for Trump, etc.
- The new organization's name would probably be "Pennsylvania Conservatives United".
- We would welcome all constitutionalists regardless of party.



Statewide Organization

- We would also invite a number of high-profile individuals to serve on the board. Again, we won't name people just yet, but we an impressive list already.
- We would likely attract a number of pro-Trump donors. In fact, one donor who wishes to remain anonymous, has already offered a 'matching funds' donation.
- With money and members, comes political power. To create state-level political change, we need a statewide organization. We believe it is time.

This project is obviously a major endeavor. In order to succeed, it requires a team of people who are <u>dedicated</u> to organization building.



If we get a sufficient number of volunteers to launch this project, the statewide group's first mission would likely be Eliminating Election Fraud (our Project #1).

In that case, we would take solid aim at Philadelphia and seek to obtain prosecutions.



Call For Volunteers. . .

Jobs We Need Filled for Our Three Projects

- <u>Fundraisers</u>: includes finding donors and/or running fundraising events. Estimated 1 hour per week.
- <u>Communications</u>: Email blasts, Facebook, Twitter, Text Messaging, Web Posts, etc. Probably a team of 3 to 5 people needed. Estimated 1 to 2 hours per week.
- <u>Graphics Designer</u>: Experienced with Photoshop or GIMP. Estimated 1 to 2 hours per week.



Jobs We Need Filled – cont'd

- Web Developer/Coder: Experienced with HTML, CSS, Boostrap, .Net, C#, SQL. Estimated 3 hours per week.
- <u>Project Managers</u>: With general team management experience. Estimated 5 hours per week.
- <u>Project Managers</u>: With Scrum Framework (or similar) experience. Estimated 5 hours per week.



Jobs We Need Filled – cont'd

- <u>Team Members</u>: For general duties. Estimated 1 hour per week
- <u>Team Members</u>: With computer skills (Word, Excel, PowerPoint). Estimated 1 to 2 hours per week
- <u>Team Members</u>: With ability to teach small classes with possible content development. Estimated 2 to 3 hours per week.
