

Do Pennsylvania teachers have the right to discuss sexual orientation or gender identity with your five-year-old? Believe it or not, no current law prohibits such conversation. Shockingly, they don't have to involve you in any decision, nor are they required to inform you that these conversations are even occurring.

We need PA Senate Bill 1278 which prohibits classroom instruction on gender identity and sexual orientation for pre-kindergarten through fifth grade students and requires adherence to existing state standards for those from sixth through twelfth grade. Additionally, SB1278 prohibits a school from withholding information from parents or legal guardians.

When you sign our Call-To-Action, the online system sends emails to your PA Senator, House Representative, Legislative Leadership and the Committee Chairs telling them to pass this into law. We need you to sign.
