

This decision was headed up by our Steering Committee who reviewed and reflected on the lack of attendance and growth over the past few years. After a presentation to our members at May General meeting. A vote was conducted and approved by overwhelming numbers.

## Activity / General Meetings 2025

- **January** – our general membership meeting landed on Thursday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, and therefore our executive board made a decision to forgo a January meeting. A few members attended in Washington, DC the inauguration of Congressman Ryan Mackenzie.
- **February** – 912 Project of The Lehigh Valley heard nominations for Board Members; a short seminar was presented on JOE, and (2) local candidates for Lehigh County for Common Pleas Judge. Additionally, videos were presented of Northampton County Council Candidates.
- **March** - LVTP board members nominated at March meeting were voted and approved. John Eastman presented a Private Screening of The Eastman Dilemma. John spoke, fielded questions and got a standing ovation.
- **April** - we hosted Pastor David Whitney who spoke on How Citizens can use their Constitution. LVTP member Heather Christein from EVA (Early Vote Action) spoke on Mail in Ballots. (2) Lehigh Candidates running for Lehigh County Executive spoke on their races.
- **May**- Our 912 Project of The Lehigh Valley Steering Committee presented Rebranding of our DBA and a five-year plan. Featured speaker, David Giordano from The John Birch Society spoke on reclaiming The Panama Canal.
- **June** – our general membership heard Shaneen Allen about her ordeal with transporting a handgun across state lines. Her talk was a great introductory to US Law Shield speaking on your rights to “Lethal Force.”
- **July**- a suggested DBA name change to LV-MAGA was presented to our membership. Local candidates from Northampton and Lehigh County spoke on their races, additionally local county GOP parties spoke. A surprise visit from Congressman Ryan Mackenzie; he spoke about The Big Beautiful Bill.
- **August** - Stephanie Catarino Wissman Executive Director | API - American Petroleum Institute Pennsylvania was our featured speaker.
- **September** - Drs. Chaminie & Greg Wheeler spoke on a new way of acquiring health care. Robert Ham a retired Nave pilot during Regan’s presidency gave us informed background of Hillsdale College.
- **October** – PA House State Representatives including Ann Flood, Zach Mako, Milou Mackenzie, and local county candidates on November ballot were our speakers
- **November** – Scott Janney announced his plans to run as a Republican candidate Senate District 18, Ben White spoke on Greater Lehigh Valley Chamber of Commerce Small Business Council, and Dr. Brian Warren spoke on Right for Life; he got a standing ovation.
- **December** - Bobby Gunther Walsh joined us with words of encouragement, US Law Shield spoke on the benefits of their coverage and Bill Backenberg, NRA President gave updates on his new role.
